Eligibility:

- 1) For Graduate Apprentice: Degree in Engineering/Technology/ (Science, Arts and Commerce etc.) General streams (B.E./B.Tech. /B. A/ B.Sc./ B. Com/BBA/BCA).
- 2) For Technical Apprentice: Diploma in Engineering/Technology (10th plus 3 years and 12th plus two years) from board of Technical Education of a State.

Note: In case suitable candidates are not available in a particular discipline, the Institute may consider eligible candidates from other relevant disciplines/streams, including the General Stream, subject to the applicable apprenticeship provisions and availability of seats.

Eligibility Conditions:

1. Candidates must satisfy all eligibility conditions prescribed under the Apprentices Act, Apprenticeship Rules and NATS guidelines applicable from time to time.
2. Candidates who have already undergone/completed apprenticeship training, or who are otherwise ineligible under the applicable provisions, shall not be considered.
3. Candidates pursuing regular Undergraduate/Postgraduate programmes, where such engagement is not permissible under the applicable apprenticeship rules, shall not be eligible.
4. Candidates having one year or more of work experience shall not be eligible, wherever applicable under the NATS/Apprenticeship provisions.
5. Candidates below 14 years of age are not eligible.
6. Postgraduate degree holders are not eligible

Selection Criteria: Shortlisted will be based on the merit of the qualifying degree/diploma. The final selection will be based on:

Qualifying degree/diploma merit:80%weightage

Interviewperformance:20%weightage

Reservation: Reservation for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) and Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) will be as per the provisions of the Apprenticeship Rules, 1992, and subsequent amendments.

Documents Required: Candidates are required to bring original documents along with self-attested photocopies at the time of interview/document verification:

1. Aadhaar Card.
2. Degree/Diploma certificate and all semester/year mark sheets.
3. Final year/semester mark sheet showing the date of passing.
4. Date of Birth proof (Matriculation Certificate or equivalent).
5. Latest updated Resume/CV.

6. Bank Passbook and/or cancelled cheque of the candidate's Aadhaar-linked bank account.
7. APAAR ID.
8. NATS 2.0 registration and completion of required E-KYC.
9. Recent passport-size photographs.
10. Caste/Category Certificate, wherever applicable.
11. Any other document required for verification under NATS/BOAT guidelines.

Engagement shall be subject to verification of the original documents and fulfillment of all eligibility conditions at the time of joining.

General Terms and Conditions:

1. Apprenticeship Training shall be governed by the Apprentices Act, 1961 and Apprenticeship Rules, as amended from time to time.
2. An apprentice shall be a trainee and not a regular employee/worker of the Institute.
3. Engagement as an apprentice shall not confer any right or claim for regular appointment/employment in NITTTR, Bhopal after completion of the training.
4. The Institute shall have no obligation to offer employment to an apprentice after successful completion of the Apprenticeship Training.
5. The apprentices shall abide by the rules, regulations, discipline, safety requirements and lawful instructions of the Institute.
6. The apprentice shall maintain proper records of the work/training undertaken during the apprenticeship period.
7. Continuation of the apprenticeship and payment of stipend shall be subject to satisfactory performance and compliance with the terms of the apprenticeship contract.
8. The apprenticeship contract may be terminated in accordance with the provisions of the Apprentices Act, Apprenticeship Rules and the terms of the contract.
9. No TA/DA, boarding or lodging shall be provided by the Institute for attending the interview.
10. Canvassing in any form shall lead to disqualification.
11. The Institute reserves the right to modify/cancel/postpone the recruitment process or vary the number of seats/discipline-wise vacancies depending upon the actual availability of seats and instructions received from BOAT (WR), Mumbai/NATS.
