Revision in Essential Qualification for Admission to PG Programmes as Recommended by the Admission Committee

The Admission Committee, in its meeting, deliberated upon the eligibility/essential qualification requirements for admission to the Postgraduate (PG) Programmes, particularly in view of the newly introduced PG Programmes.

Based on the recommendations of the Admission Committee, necessary changes have been proposed in the PG Ordinances at Page 9, Clause 3 and Clause 3.1 – “Essential Qualification for Admission to the PG Programmes.” The corresponding changes are proposed to be incorporated in **Table-5: Criteria 2, Page 11**. The revised provisions, as recommended in the **Minutes of Meeting (MoM) of the Admission Committee (marked*)**.
