1. As per Government of India reservation norms, the reservation for the advertised Posts are as follows: UR – 10, OBC – 05, SC – 03, ST-01 and EWS – 01.
2. The Institute reserves the right to increase and decrease the vacancies advertised. The Institute also reserves the right to cancel the Advertisement without assigning any reasons.

3. The engagement is purely on temporary basis for a period of 11 months (This may or may not be extended further). In case of extension, it can be given based on performance evaluation and recommendation of HoDs / Deans of respective Schools.
4. The remuneration will be as follows :
 - a. Assistant Professor on Contract with Ph.D. degree: ₹80,000 per month (consolidated).
 - b. Assistant Professor on Contract with Master's degree: ₹65,000 per month (consolidated)
4. No other emoluments / allowances / medical reimbursement are applicable. No vacation salary is payable. No compensatory leaves are applicable.
5. Retired faculty, preferably from Government Institutes may also apply for Contract appointment, however, the remuneration and other terms & conditions will be governed by Govt. of India norms as issued from time to time.
6. Candidates must write their Email ID neatly and correctly for mailing written examination/Interview/appointment letter as an attachment. The email date will be considered as the official date of dispatch and receipt of communication. Candidate not having an email-ID must create an ID and check it regularly for further communication.
7. The university shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted at any time at the time of engagement or during the tenure of service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted are fake or the candidate has clandestine antecedents / background and has suppressed the said information, his/her services shall be terminated forthwith.
8. Candidates, who have obtained degrees or diplomas or certificates for various courses from any Institution declared fake/derecognized by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi shall not be eligible for being considered for recruitment to the posts advertised.
9. No person shall be recruited unless he/she is in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect that is likely to interfere with the efficient performance of his official duties. Before a candidate recruited directly is finally approved for appointment to the establishment, he shall be required to produce a medical certificate of physical fitness from a doctor specified by the appointing authority.
10. Candidates offered the position will have to join within one week and should produce the original marksheets/certificates and testimonials along with address proof at the time of joining.
11. Errors and omissions in the notification and selection process are subject to correction.
