Additionally, candidates are required to attach a detailed (minimum 500 words) research proposal in the application, outlining the objectives of the research work they intend to undertake during the fellowship period. <i>Note: Sending only a resume / CV by email will not be considered as a complete application.</i> 4. The shortlisted candidates will be notified by email for interview. Therefore, please mention active Mobile Number and Email ID in the resume / CV. 5. Recent passport size photographs and photocopies of relevant certificates and other testimonials in support of age, qualification, experience etc. will be collected at an appropriate stage. 6. The applicant will be responsible for the authenticity of information submitted / documents and photographs. It is the responsibility of the candidate to assess his / her own eligibility for the post(s) for which he/she is appearing in accordance with this advertisement. If it is detected at any time in future, during the process of selection or even after the appointment that the candidate was not eligible as per the prescribed eligibility criteria in this advertisement, which could not be detected at the time of selection for whatsoever reason, his/her candidature / appointment shall be liable to be cancelled / terminated immediately.
